### Re: Drop-off/Pick-up and Parking

Parents/Guardians,

We are sending this message to you as a reminder of the plans set in place for the safety of all of our students at ÉWMMS, ÉJHS and ÉASC. The plan set forth was done in consultation with experts in the area of traffic flow and with support from infrastructure.

There are now, well over 600 students between the 3 schools (Allain St-Cyr included). This has created an unprecedented amount of traffic for this location. A great deal of effort went into designing a dropoff area and traffic flow pattern that will work for the busy times in the morning and after school.

While it has been working quite well overall as most of the parents/guardians are following the safe procedures, there have been vehicles parking in the drop off lanes. If you are escorting your child/ren into the school area that you please **park in the designated parking areas** and **not the drop off only** (kiss and ride) areas. There is also parking on the left hand side of the primary drop off lane. You may also use the 19 spots located just below the bus lane as parking. Both ÉWMMS and ÉASC have older students here who do not require an escort and parents are very much used to dropping them off and leaving. It makes the drop off area unsafe if they are not able to pull in a drop their child/ren off.

We would like to extend our gratitude to all parents for making this busy time as safe as possible for all of our students.
