Northwest students are taught the Territories curriculum using the Montessori philosophy and materials. The Montessori philosophy emphasizes learning through independence, freedom within limits, and handson material, allowing the children to develop intellectually, emotionally and socially, while developing a life-long love of learning.

The Yellowknife Montessori School

We operate our Casa program in two locations for your convience. Two classrooms at our dowtown school and two classrooms located at NJ MacPherson School. Many of our Casa students continue on with the public Montessori program a NJ MacPherson, described below.

Montessori Public School Program

The Society also supports the Public Montessori Education partnership with Yellowknife Education District No.1. The public program operates grades K-5 at NJ MacPherson School through a multi-grade approach. Students enter the sytem through Montessori Kindergarten and progress to Lower Elementary for ages 6-9 and Upper Elementary Classes for ages 9-12.

Summer Camp

An Annual Summer Camp program runs through the months of July – August for ages 3 – 5.

Areas of Learning

Practical Life:

Through practical life exercises, children learn to care for themselves, one another and their environment. They help develop concentration, coordination and independence.

Sensorial:

Materials in the sensorial area allow the children to analyze and explore. This helps them broaden and refine sense perceptions.

Math:

Math materials and manipulatives allow for concrete experience with number concepts. The children are introduced to the quantity 1-10 and progressively 1-1000.

Language:

Language exercises nourish the children's vocabulary, enhance self-expression and develop a foundation for reading, writing and listening skills.

Cultural:

Science, History, Geography, Art and Music introduce the children to the world and the living things within it.

Enrichment:

The curriculum also includes programming in languages and physical education.
