Covid Corner

Thank you for being so diligent in the screening of your children each day. A reminder that:

- 1) A student with **ONE minor symptom must stay home for 24 hours**. If they are better within 24 hours, they may return to school. If they are not better or are worsening, they must call public health for next steps.
- 2) A child with **ONE Major or TWO or MORE minor symptoms must stay home** and call public health for next steps.

Adults in the building - We have installed a doorbell in between our two main doors.

Drop Off:

We are asking that parents bring students to the door, ring the bell, and wait for a staff member to let them in. The staff member will make sure the student checks in at the office and gets to their classroom safely.

Pick up:

Driving:

- Please call from your vehicle and we will send the students out to you.

- Please call from the front door and we will send the students out to you
- If you aren't able to call, please ring the doorbell
