- Mental Health of our Students
  - Considering the shootings that have happened recently in Texas, it was brought up that we need to be aware of the well being of all of our students/children
  - Making sure our students/children feel safe, seen, and heard
  - Creating an environment where everyone feels valued
  - Academic councillors, PSTs, and CYCCs are build relationships with the students within our schools
  - Parents/families also play a roll in cultivating a healthy/welcoming/inclusive environment

## • Follow up from May PAC meeting regarding False absence notifications

- The Auto-dialer to notify parents of student absences go out twice a day: at 9:30am and 6:30pm. Students may be marked absent accidentally for various reasons: e.g., student has entered the class after the teacher has taken attendance, the student does not respond when their name is called. This can cause parents to worry if they receive a call that their student is absent when they are at school.
- Some solutions: if students are more than 15 minutes late to a class have them check in at the front office. Parent or student to notify the school if their student will be absent, even if it is a school event (e.g., sports, youth parliament, etc.) as it is difficult for each teacher to know if the student is away for a school activity. If a parent receives a student absence notification and are concerned, parents are encouraged to call the front office as the student may have come in after the auto-dialer has made the absence call and/or staff can check if the student is in class.
