✤ Admin Report

- \$91,000 was carried over from last year.
- Budget money will be spent on:
 - Paying for increased need for subs.
 - Upgrading laptops for some teachers.
 - Upgrading chrome books.
 - Replacing textbooks.
 - Sensory room
 - Blinds for some classrooms
- The school manages 61 bank accounts (various clubs, etc.)
- Soccer field is complete

- CYCC 1 councillor has started. 1 more councillor needs to be hired.
- Awards from last year. Groups of about 50 students meet in the foyer to present awards.
- 748 students are registered at SJF this year. Mature students 19-21 years old go to Route 21.
- Grade 12 diploma exams currently going to happen (but this could change) based on what Alberta does.
- Second semester students will get their schedule ahead of time. Students may change whether they go in the morning or afternoon. Based on number of students in each class.
- Is there a possibly of full time for all students in 2nd semester? Not at this time, depends on social distancing rules.
