Race Distances:

Pewee (8-9) and Bantam (10-11): Two laps of a 1 km loop
Midgets (12-13): Three laps of 1 km loop
Juveniles (14-15): Four laps of 1 km loop
Juniors (16-17): 7.5 km (two laps of a specially marked course)
Open (18+): 7.5 km (two laps of a specially marked course)
